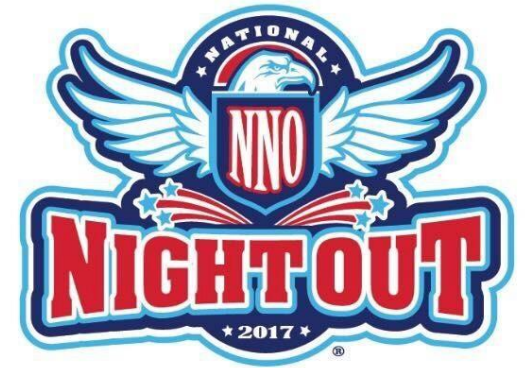

WHAT IS NATIONAL NIGHT OUT?

National Night Out was first held back in 1984 as the brainchild of the National Association of Town Watch.

Involving local neighborhood watch groups, local police agencies, civic groups, state/regional crime prevention associations and volunteers, this first event unified over 2.5 million people in 23 states.

It wasn't long before those simple front porch vigils blossomed into block parties, parades, festivals, cookouts, youth events, safety demonstrations and emergency personnel visits.

This event emerged into a community building campaign to encourage and promote police-community partnerships as well as neighborhood camaraderie.

It has become a great opportunity to bring our law enforcement and neighbors together under positive circumstances to work on making our communities safer, caring places to live.

Today over 38 Million people across the United States and Canada participate in these fun-filled events.
